Safe Return to In-Person Instruction and Continuity of Services Plan

2023 - 2024

1] First line of defense - Parents

If a student is showing signs of illness, we strongly recommend keeping him/her at home. The easiest way to prevent the spread of any virus is to be aware and cautious of signs and symptoms. Please help us keep all of our students healthy.

2] School Buses

Social distancing will be encouraged while on the bus.

3] Upon arrival to school, students will report to:

K - 8: Cafeteria

- Students may use the restroom, get breakfast, etc by gaining teacher permission
- Teachers may use this time as they deem appropriate: homework check in, fun discussions, brain teasers, etc. ○ Students will begin school work at 7:45 a.m.
- Teachers will report to the administrator any student who is showing symptoms, such as coughing, sneezing etc.
- Any student who is showing symptoms will be sent to the office for a checklist screening
 - Temperature
 - Cough?
 - Sneezing?
 - Other issues/symptoms experienced
- If a student is experiencing a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher, the parent will be contacted, and the student will be

sent home.

- If a student is coughing or sneezing excessively, a facemask will be recommended when returning to their classroom.
- If a student is vomiting, the parent will be contacted, and the student **will be sent home**.

Staff Expectations:

- Staff members will be expected to self-monitor signs and symptoms of illness. Although daily temperature checks will not be mandatory at school, it is expected that staff members exercise precaution and awareness.

4] Lunch

Lunch tables spaced 5 - 10 feet apart

Students will eat with home room groups

Each group will disinfect their specific table after the shift is over

Parents/Guardians will not be allowed to eat lunch with their children until further notice

5] Recess/Physical Education

Physical activity is an essential part of the well being of school age children. Recess will continue to be offered. K-4 recess time will not be required to be staggered when held outside. Teachers will designate a rotation for class use of outdoor areas(swings, carousel, play equipment, basketball court, etc.) Indoor recess time will be held in classrooms, so no time adjustment is needed. Physical education will still occur. Equipment used will be wiped down after each class.

6] Facemasks

Facemasks will not be required for students or staff, unless for a reason listed above. If a student or staff member wishes to wear a mask, the district will support that decision and will provide said mask if requested.

7] Handwashing

Frequent hand washing will be promoted by school staff. Hand sanitizer will be provided at several locations around the Campus.

8] Cleaning

Holliday C-2 will implement routine cleaning on a daily basis for all high touch surfaces.

9] Physical distancing

Holliday C-2 will ensure that physical distancing is maintained whenever possible and appropriate within the school setting.

10] Contact Tracing

Contact tracing will be conducted by school staff when requested by the Monroe County Health Department.

11] Vaccinations

Holliday C-2 will share information in regards to vaccinations with stakeholders when appropriate.

12] Accommodations

Holliday C-2 will provide accommodations as necessary or as mandated by student IEPs.

13] Visitors

Potential visitors to the building must call ahead to gain permission from the office at 660-266-3412.

14] Continuity of Services

Teachers will use this information to guide instruction and address the Missouri Learning Standards during the 2023-2024 school year. The district will continue to provide Chromebooks or devices to all students in grades K-8 and teachers during the 2023-2024 school year. The District also provides access to Wi-Fi hotspots in the event that a family is unable to acquire internet connectivity and/or access. The district will continue to provide social emotional support to students and staff as needed.

15] Periodic Revision

The Safe Return Plan will be reviewed and updated by the Holliday C-2 school board when necessary.

16] Understandable Language

In the event that a stakeholder communicates in a language other than English, a transcribed version, whether written or oral,

will be provided to him/her in an understandable language.

In the event that personnel needs outweigh our ability to effectively operate, Holliday C-2 will begin a temporary closure. The length of which will be determined by the administration and school board. Teachers will hold daily Zoom sessions during this time to check in with students to the best of our abilities. A schedule to follow will be sent home in the event of a needed school closure.
